# Plus English Programs (Add-on)

## Super Intensive Filmmaking



In this 8-week program, students begin by studying weeks 1-4 at Rennert to improve their English and fluency. In weeks 4-8 students study at New York Film Academy in an intensive Filmmaking workshop.

English-4 weeks: Study Rennert's intensive 22 American English program for 4 weeks where you will improve your listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in order to reach an upper intermediate level of English.

Filmmaking-4 weeks: Students have 2 options: 16mm film or digital film. These workshops are 4-week, full-time programs. Students study 30 hours of classes per week, which meet Monday through Friday. Students will also engage in filmmaking projects for class on nights and weekends.

### Filmmaking Classes

Filmmaking classes are structured around the production of three short film projects of increasing complexity from conception to completion, in intensive classes and hands-on film workshops. On nights and weekends students spend time writing, choosing locations, shooting, directing, and editing films. At the end of the course, students have the opportunity to screen their films to the students and faculty of New York Film Academy and Rennert. Upon successful completion of this workshop, students will be granted 4 college credits by New York Film Academy.

NYFA's 4-Week Filmmaking Workshop is an introduction and exploration of the visual language and techniques of cinema. Throughout the four weeks, students learn how to create a shot, sequence, and scene, writing, directing, shooting, and editing a series of short film projects. Through this process, students learn to use digital cameras, film lighting packages, and digital editing software provided by NYFA. In total, students produce three short films of increasing complexity.

NYFA students each direct their own films, and crew on the short films of their peers, rotating amongst key crew positions. Through this, students gain experience not only in directing, but as the Director of Photography, Assistant Camera, and Gaffer/Grip. Classes in directing, writing, editing, cinematography, and production round out the curriculum.

Every week, students' films are screened and critiqued in class with the instructor. When the workshop concludes, NYFA hosts an exclusive screening that students can invite family and friends to attend. NYFA's workshop students often continue their studies in advanced filmmaking programs.

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## Super Intensive Filmmaking

### How To Book This Course: Super Intensive Filmmaking

1. Provide Rennert Admissions Coordinator a completed Rennert English Registration Form indicating that the student is applying for the Super Intensive Filmmaking Program.
2. Please arrange a Skype or phone interview with the Rennert Admissions Coordinator and the student. An upper-intermediate Level of English is required for this program. The booking request will not be confirmed until the interview has been completed.
3. If the student is accepted into the program, we will send you an email confirming the student's admission. Please provide Proof of High School Graduation (High School Diploma). This document copy must be in English. If the document is not in English, please provide a signed and notarized translation along with a copy of the non-English document. Please know that Rennert Translations offers translation and notarization services for a small fee.
4. When New York Film Academy confirms receipt and acceptance Rennert will send you a copy of the NYFA Application Form to be completed by the student. Please have the student complete and return that form. Please disregard the application fee.
5. Once the student has been registered with NYFA, we will confirm the full booking by sending you the invoice and confirmation documents for both the English Course and Super Intensive Filmmaking course.
6. The Super Intensive Filmmaking Program requires an F-1 Student Visa. Your Rennert Admissions Coordinator will issue the I-20 Form at this point.
7. Upon arrival at Rennert for English courses, we will provide them with NYFA course information and assist with the visa transfer process from Rennert to NYFA.
8. Rennert requires full payment for all Super Intensive Filmmaking + English bookings at least 2 weeks prior to the English course start date.
9. Please note: the student must bring the original Proof of High School Graduation (and original notarized translation, if applicable) with him or her when traveling to the U.S.: NYFA will require the student to present this document before he or she can begin class there.

## Acting for Film at NYFA



### Learn Introductory Film Acting Skills at NYFA

This hands-on workshop provides students with a thorough foundation of acting skills with a specific focus on film acting. Classes emphasize the essential elements of the craft of acting using a variety of American acting techniques which may include Method and Meisner as starting points. The 4-Week Acting for Film workshop is a full immersion into the craft of acting. In conjunction with these classes, students also participate in courses designed to train the actor for the technical requirements of acting on a film set. No significant prior experience or knowledge is assumed. This acting workshop brings everyone to the same level quickly, beginning with the fundamentals and filling the inevitable gaps in understanding of those with some prior experience. Many students who complete the 4-Week Acting for Film Workshop join longer programs, such as our 8-Week Acting for Film Workshop or the 1-Year Acting for Film Certificate, intensifying their studies and gaining more experience in front of the camera.

### Acting For Film

Acting for Film provides students with an environment to get comfortable acting in front of the camera. The primary emphasis of the class is the practice of the subtlety and nuance of film acting including learning to adjust the performance for specific shot size, finding the arc of the character, and learning to maintain the integrity of the script while shooting out of sequence. Film set terminology and etiquette are also addressed. Students participate in a Production Workshop with film students. In the Production workshop, students experience on-set shoots in collaboration with student filmmakers. Students are introduced to a first-hand experience in set etiquette, shooting out of sequence, and understanding the actor's role in a shoot.

### Scene Study

Students learn to analyze scripts and break them down into units or "beats". They develop a solid grounding in establishing a character based on their own experiences and imagination. Students will incorporate all of the disparate disciplines learned in all other Areas of Study in an in-class, filmed scene presentation.

## Acting for Film at NYFA

### Acting Technique

Students will practice the tools necessary to hone and focus their acting skills when they do not have a scene partner on which to rely. Students will work on monologues from theatre and film sources that will help them learn how to command attention at auditions and professional performances. Exercises will be taped for in-class critique.

### Voice & Movement

Students learn to access their natural voice through relaxation exercises designed to improve alignment and alleviate habitual tension. They will also experiment with different ways of becoming physically “present” in their work. Elements of various approaches will be taught to assist students in finding freedom and expression in the physical instrument.

### Monologues

Students will work on assigned and chosen monologues to practice text analysis, and character creation skills learned thus far. Students will understand the structure and particular elements, which make a successful monologue and prepare pieces to be audition ready.

### Special Topics

This course offers students the opportunity to explore key acting topics. Topics covered relate to the craft and/or industry and give students current insights to apply to a career or further studies.

## Dance



Students interested in studying dance in New York City can add this course to any English program at Rennert.

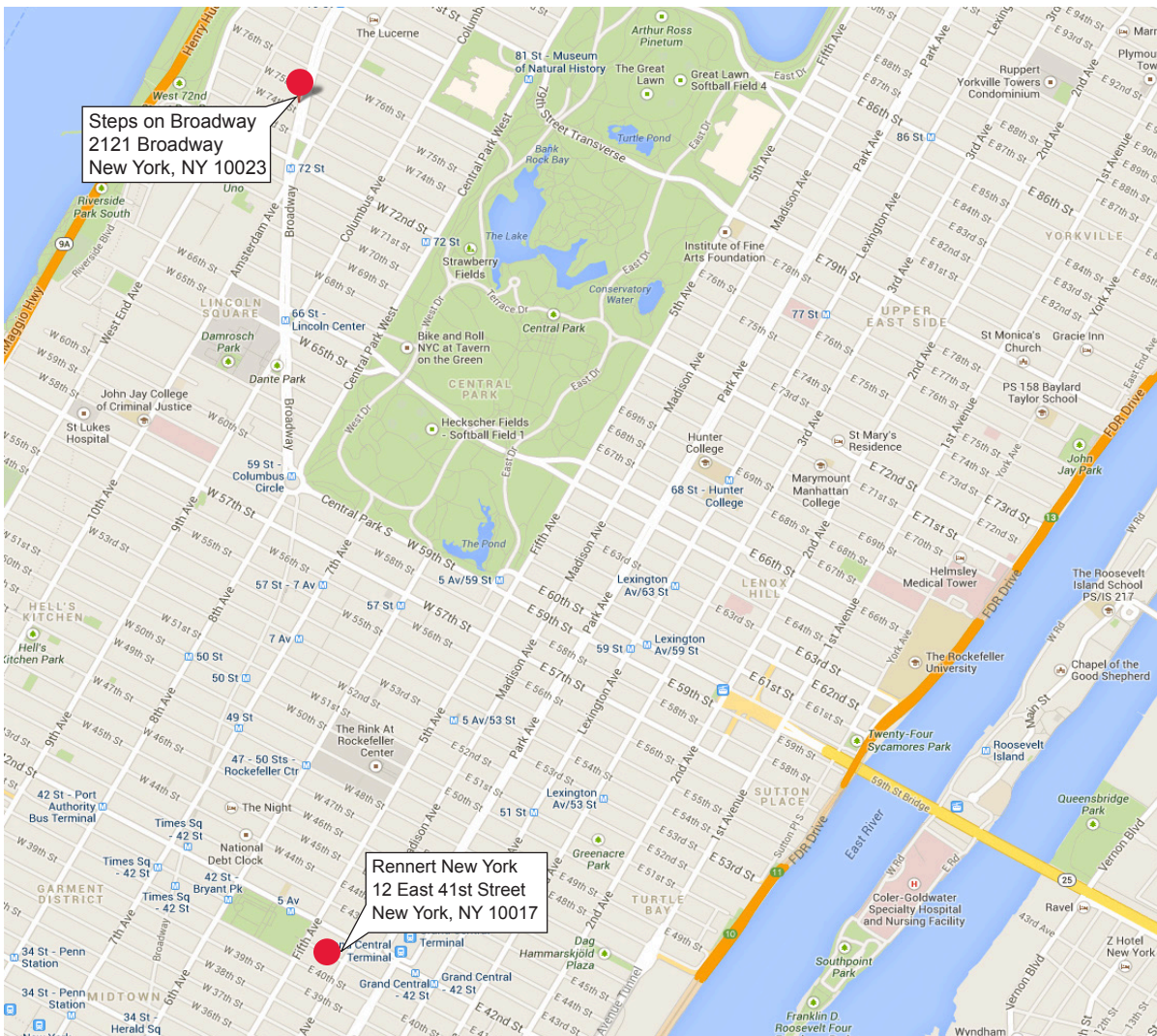

# Plus English Programs (Add-on)

## Music



Rennert's Music Plus English program combines English lessons during the day at Rennert and private Music lessons in the evenings or weekends at our partner school, Lucy Moses School.

### Music Classes

These one-to-one lessons focus on each student's individual needs, based on the music questionnaire that is filled out in advance. Classes meet for a minimum of two hours per week for a minimum of two weeks. Additional hours or weeks may be added.

Students can choose any musical instrument or tract they like.

# Plus English Programs (Add-on)

## Photography



Rennert's Photography Plus English course allows students to develop their English skills while also pursuing a hobby. Learn the basics of amateur photography from experienced photographers at our partner studio PhotoUno. Students can combine this course with any 16, 20, 22 or 30-lesson English program.

### Classes

#### Photography I (beginner)

This 12-hour hands-on course is intended for beginners and amateur photographers who own a digital camera and want to learn basic and intermediate photography techniques and take great pictures using different settings. This course may be taken in a 3 or 6-week format. Students learn about:

- Shutter speed
- Aperture
- ISO exposure
- Focus control
- Lighting
- Composition
- Point of view

#### (Optional) Outdoor Classes - \$80-100/class\*

Unique 2-hour workshops take you to places such as the Brooklyn Bridge by night, Williamsburg, the High Line, Chinatown, Grand Central, SoHo and more. These workshops are given each month throughout the year so there is always one available. This course can be combined with a 16 or 20-lesson English course.
